Vice presidential candidate: Mike Pence

- Allow parents to enroll in tax-free dependent care savings accounts for their children or elderly relatives.
- Protect and defend the bill of rights, including the freedom of religion, speech, press and right to bear arms.
- Develop the offensive cyber capabilities needed to deter attacks by both state and non-state actors and, if necessary, to respond appropriately.
- Boost growth to 3.5
 percent per year on average, with the
 potential to reach a 4 percent growth
 rate.
- Establish the national goal of providing school choice to every one of the 11 million school aged children living in poverty.
- Repeal and replace
 Obamacare with Health Savings
 Accounts (HSAs).
- Protect the economic well-being of the lawful immigrants already living here by curbing uncontrolled foreign worker admissions.

- A \$25 billion fund will support historically black colleges and universities, Hispanic-serving institutions, and other minorityserving institutions in building new ladders of opportunity for students.
- Expand background checks to more gun sales—including by closing the gun show and internet sales loopholes—and strengthen the background check system by getting rid of the so-called "Charleston Loophole."
- Fund paid leave by making the wealthy pay their fair share not by increasing taxes on working families.
- Fight for full federal equality for LGBT Americans.
- Fundamentally reform veterans' health care to ensure access to timely and high quality care and block efforts to privatize the VA.
- Reduce American oil consumption by a third through cleaner fuels and more efficient cars, boilers, ships, and trucks.

- Elimination of special interest tax loopholes, to get rid of the double-taxation on small businesses, and the replacement of all income and payroll taxes with a single consumption tax.
- Eliminate the federal Department of Education.
- Create a more efficient system of providing work visas, conducting background checks, and incentivizing non-citizens to pay their taxes and obtain proof of employment.
- Strike a balance between our shared American values of religious liberty and freedom from discrimination.
- Remove cannabis from Schedule I of the federal Controlled Substances Act, which will allow individual states to make their own decisions about both recreational and medical marijuana.
- Cut off the funding on which violent extremist armies depend

- Guarantee economic human rights, including access to food, water, housing, and utilities, with effective anti-poverty programs to ensure every American a life of dignity.
- Establish a foreign policy based on diplomacy, international law, and human rights.
- Create a Truth and Reconciliation Commission to understand and eliminate legacy of slavery that lives on as pervasive racism in the economy, education, housing and health.
